#### **Objective:**

Produce refined and bleached soybean oil from crude soybean oil and produce biodiesel within required product specifications. Operators are required to maintain knowledge of the process flow, computerized equipment and be aware of hazards associated with the process. Collect data and track product inventory. Continuous plant operations requires 12 hour shift work. Employees must be able to adapt to 12-hour workdays and be able to meet call-in requirements.

# **Essential job functions**

- Exhibit safe work practices as a condition of employment, discussing problems or unsafe conditions with management.
- Perform various quality control functions on oil, biodiesel, glycerin, fatty acid, and water, visual inspection
  of all types of inventory, measuring physical inventory on a periodic basis and operation of lab equipment
  according to procedure.
- Conduct continuous inspections of key process points, make necessary machinery and equipment adjustments, identify problems on equipment, and continually monitor equipment under your direction.
- Gather samples of laboratory analysis as scheduled/require, and perform and record required control analyses.
- Ability to perform all types of general facility maintenance and housekeeping, including equipment inspections, repairs, adjustments and monitoring throughout the facility.
- Participate in projects intended for improve efficiency and reduce operating costs.
- Maintain logs of key production variables such as production volume, yield, plant uptime and utility consumption on a timely basis.
- Perform the necessary safety inspections to maintain the equipment in safe and efficient operation condition
- Communicate any production problems that may occur to other Operators and/or management.
- Complete work in a timely, accurate and thorough manner and is conscientious about assignments.
- Coordinate work functions with fellow bio-refinery employees and other departments.
- Maintain designated sanitary schedule to MnSP standards
- Access storage facilities to monitor product inventories
- Complete training program and pass a written exam on operating procedures and emergency shutdown procedures as required by the Process Safety Management Committee.
- Foster a culture of safe behavior and environmental compliance at all times.
- Work in an honest and ethical manner; maintain confidentiality on all business related matters.
- Physically report to work on time at their assigned locations and is seldom absent.
- Maintain a team environment with other departments at all times.
- Maintain a high level of customer service and friendly atmosphere.
- Follow all company policies and procedures.
- Other duties as assigned.
