Objective: Keep buildings and grounds in clean and orderly condition. Perform cleaning duties, such as cleaning floors, windows, and removing rubbish. Duties include performing routine maintenance activities, notifying management of need for repairs, lawn care, and snow removal. Continuous plant operations requires 12 hour shift work. Employees must be able to adapt to 12-hour workdays and be able to meet call-in requirements.

Essential job functions

- Clean building floors by vacuuming, sweeping, and mopping of flooring.
- Clean and sanitize restrooms and locker rooms.
- Clean sinks, countertops, microwaves, and refrigerators in break room and kitchen.
- Restock supplies in restrooms and breakroom.
- Gather and empty trash and recyclables, replace liners, clean receptacles as necessary.
- Dust and clean furniture and fixtures using cleaners, sponges, and squeegees. Clean windowsills and windows.
- Maintain janitor closets in a clean, organized and safe manor.
- Mix water and detergents or acids in containers to prepare cleaning solutions, according to specifications following procedures for the use of chemical cleaners, in order to prevent damage to floors and fixtures. Including proper labeling, dilution and use of all chemicals.
- Mow and trim lawns and shrubbery, using mowers and hand and power trimmers, and clear debris from grounds.
- Remove snow from roadways, sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, rail areas, using snowplows, snow blowers, and snow shovels, and spread snow melting chemicals.
- Perform minor repairs; notifying appropriate management the need for major repairs.
- Touch-up painting as needed.
- Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.
- Participate in monthly training classes as required on environmental, health and safety.
- Follow all company policies and procedures.
- Foster a culture of safe behavior and environmental compliance at all times.
- Work in an honest and ethical manner; maintain confidentiality on all business related matters.
- Physically report to work on time at their assigned locations and is seldom absent.
- Maintain a team environment with other departments at all times.
- Maintain a high level of customer service and friendly atmosphere.
- Work extended hours or additional overtime as needed to meet business demands.
- Perform other duties as assigned or needed.
